

Creative Writing for the Media Program 2009-2011

In exchange for the exceptional learning opportunities offered by CWMP and recognizing that each participant influences the experience of the entire cohort, we ask each applicant to read the following and, if amenable, sign below.

If accepted as a member of the 2009-2011 cohort of the CWMP, I will:

1. Give top priority to meeting all CWMP requirements. This includes, but is not limited to, enrolling in each of the six CWMP courses -- one per quarter over the duration of this two-year program.

CWMP makes every effort to coordinate its course offerings to avoid conflict with other RTVF/theatre sequences. However, if a scheduling conflict does arise, CWMP participants promise to give top priority to CWMP enrollment.

Joining CWMP prevents participation in study abroad or out of area internships during my junior and senior academic years. Summer activities are not affected.

Failure to complete any of the six CWMP courses means that I will not earn a certificate and may not be allowed to continue in the program. An exception may be allowed under special conditions such as serious health or family problems.

2. Take independent responsibility for meeting the requirements of each CWMP course.

Participants are expected to rise to professional standards of behavior. For example, extracurricular activities are not a valid excuse for lateness, failure to attend class or failure to complete assignments. Syllabi may include significant grade penalties for this and other nonprofessional behavior.
