\*\*In the second year, students participate in two full-time external practica. One of these is in a public school; the other is in a health facility (hospital, rehabilitation center) or a private practice. During the remaining two quarters, students participate in on-site practica and register for one elective. The scheduling of practica varies across students.

#### Pre-requisite courses:

Students with background may be required to take statistics in their 2nd year based on the results of a placement exam.

Students without background may apply to the MA program. If accepted, they will participate in a leveling year consisting of all required and recommended courses below.
