

Dance Minor Requirements for Students Matriculating in 2010

Dance Minor 2010

No course for any SoC minor may be taken utilizing the P/N option, and all classes must be completed at a grade of C- or better in order to apply toward a minor.

Double Counting

Students **may not** double count courses between their dance minor and any other major, minor, or certificate either inside or outside of SoC.

Requirements for a Minor in Dance (7 units)

For a minor in the dance program, students must take at least 5 courses in the department. No courses for the minor may be taken utilizing the P/N option, and all classes must be completed with a grade of C- or higher in order to be counted toward the minor.

- 3 courses from the primary and secondary core:

DANCE 101-1	Dance in Context
DANCE 101-2	Movement Awareness
DANCE 225	Dance Composition
- History/Theory/Criticism (1 course)

All courses from this area are open to students pursuing the minor. In addition, students may take courses from other departments that have been predetermined to fulfill requirements in dance (e.g. Gender and Sexuality in Physical Performance in gender studies or Performance and Culture in performance studies).

DANCE 335 Special Topics in Dance Research (methods or history topics)

DANCE 399 Independent Study (history/theory/criticism topics)

- 2 units of dance technique in modern and Jump Rhythm techniques (each dance technique class carries .34 unit, so 6 classes add up to the 2-unit requirement); these classes do not need to be taken in a 3-course sequence.
- One remaining dance elective reflecting the student's special interests. (Note: A technique sequence may not be used to satisfy this requirement).
- Two courses must be taken at the 300 level or above.
